



## Microsoft Windows 7 / Track Star AVLS Testing

Microsoft will be officially releasing Windows 7 on October 22, 2009. To determine the interoperability of Track Star AVLS with this new operating system, Track Star has secured the Final Release Candidate for Windows 7 Enterprise Edition from Microsoft in advance of the release and performed tests. This document details those tests and the results gathered.

In order to most closely duplicate the environment that users will first use to deploy Windows 7, the testing that was performed by Track Star was undertaken on a computer upgraded to Windows 7 rather than on a new computer equipped with Windows 7 from the manufacturer. Once those computers become available, Track Star will conduct further testing and release a subsequent report. This testing was performed on a Pentium 4 class machine with a processor running at 2.8 GHz and equipped with 1 Gigabyte of RAM. The computer was equipped with a DVD ROM drive, a 250 Gigabyte hard drive, a Netgear WPM111 Network Interface Adapter and a GE Force 8400GS video card with 512 Megabytes of DDR2 memory.

The install of the Windows 7 OS was done on a computer previously equipped with Microsoft Windows XP Professional.

Following the installation, Track Star AVLS was found to still exist on the computer in a folder that the OS installation process created called windows.old. Running the application from this location by double clicking on the Track Star AVLS application while exploring the drive resulted in the application running properly.

Subsequently, the existing windows.old folder was removed and a new installation of Track Star AVLS was undertaken. The installation process completed successfully and the application ran properly in the new OS when the installation was complete. Testing of the application in the Windows 7 environment has included report generation, vehicle replay, administrative functions and all other aspects of the application. All aspects of the application operated without difficulty.

Based on this testing, Track Star AVLS has been found to operate satisfactorily in Microsoft Windows 7. Further testing will continue with various configurations and results will be provided in subsequent Technical Bulletins.
